We want you to think 1800's. Your flag should be a replica of a Newfoundland's British Colony flag from that time period. Because Jacob. A. Crocker was a fisherman, he most likely waved the Red Jack as well on his ship. Entrants can also submit this design. You have creative license as to how large you make your flag (s). Winning flags will be hung up at 10pm on the Jacob A. Crocker House (first place) and the Trout River Interpretive Building (2nd place). All non-winning entrants are encouraged to wave their flags during the Canada Day Parade through Trout River at 2pm. For those who enjoy woodworking we are also having a Royal British Newfoundland Arms contest. Plaques must be replicas from the 1800's designs that would have appeared in Newfoundland at the time. Winning arms plaques will be placed on the two buildings in the same manner as the winning flags. Winners will receive a Heritage Seasonal Pass for 2017 and are automatically allowed to enter the upcoming Colony Quilting Bee competition without any contest application fee.
